<b>Initiative and Drive</b>	Takes proactive steps to go beyond what is expected. Shows self-motivation, curiosity, and a positive attitude toward challenges.	20
<b>Contribution to Team and Workplace</b>	Positively impacts their team or workplace through collaboration, work ethic, and a willingness to support others.	20
<b>Communication and Professionalism</b>	Displays clear, respectful communication, professionalism, and maturity appropriate to their role and experience level.	15
<b>Impact and Achievement</b>	Evidence of meaningful contributions, task ownership, or improvement in performance. Recognised by peers or supervisors for excellence.	15
